



Best Way to Clean Wood Floors

Step by Step

1. Mix a capful of Methylated spirits into a bucket of water ;(50ml in 10L of warm water)
2. Ensure mop is well wrung out before use;
3. Do not flood floor;
4. For stubborn stains, use a hand cloth and the water with methylated spirits. Wring out well and rub the area manually.

Main Points

Listen to your Floor Sander

After your floor is polished, make sure you stay off the floor for the recommended amount of time. Do not open any windows/doors to look at the floor. Different air flow can affect the drying/finished result of the floor.

Take reasonable steps to protect your floor but remember it is made for living on..... ENJOY IT!



What will hurt your wood floors

- **Pets/ Animals** – try and keep animals off your wood floors. Their nails will leave tiny scratches all over your newly polished wood floors. If your pets have to be on the floors, ensure their nails are clipped regularly to try and limit the damage.
- **Stiletto heels/ high heels** – the weight transferred through a stiletto heel by a 55kg person is equivalent to an elephant. They will leave little dents all over your floor.
- **Sand** – by ensuring children (and adults) empty sand out of their shoes or leave their shoes by the door can limit the sand on your floor. Sand is extremely coarse and can scratch the floor.
- **Dragging furniture** – put protective felts on the bottom of all your movable furniture and ensure all furniture is lifted and placed when it is moved (never dragged).
- **Excessive sunlight, water and some chemicals will affect your floors.**
